# Hilltop Reserved Matters Update



We have gained approval for our detailed planning application (PA21/04772) at Hilltop from Cornwall Council and we will be seeking a delivery partner to help bring this forward.

#### The changes that we made include:

- · Site layout has been changed to preserve key viewing corridors within the World Heritage Site
- · Reducing the size of homes to make them more accessible for the local housing market
- Reducing development footprint by 25% making more space for landscaping, boosting the site's ecological value



#### Wider Development Update

We're reviewing the best way to deliver the next phases of the development, either on our own or with partners. We're also undertaking a structural survey of the partially built buildings next to the estuary.

The surveys cover two basements, and three concrete frame structures south of North Quay Road. They are ongoing, with results being recorded over the next few weeks.

The next step is to perform onsite integrity testing of the completed works under structural engineers' supervision. Once the testing and reports are done, the team will decide on the next steps for this area.

#### Hayle North Quay Big Beach Clean

#### Harbour Wall

A structural review of the collapsed section of the harbour wall has been completed to assess repair costs.

The development cannot fund the repairs alone, so we applied to Cornwall Council for funding, but the application was unsuccessful. We are now exploring other funding options. This will not impact other activities, such as the delivery of the third-party development at South Quay.

#### Hayle Harbour Office Relocation

As part of a review, the Harbour Authority has moved from their old office to the site office at Hayle North Quay. This change helps them keep managing and maintaining the harbour while dealing with ongoing financial challenges.

















#### Site improvements

We've been busy making some improvements around the site, which has included removing the cranes and portakabin at the Harbour and installing new planters around the development.

We have also improved the access to the beach at Gilberts. Meanwhile, Escape to the Sauna has further invested into their public offering by constructing a new fence, adding to the privacy and security of their facility.
